I. Call to Order

VI. Committee Chair Reports

The committee chairs/committees are in the process of being formed

-Concessions- Concessions Operator, Roseanne Geyer, is retiring. She will no longer run gameday concessions for us. We are in need of two volunteers to take over this responsibility. Concessions generate a lot of proceeds for the program. There is an additional need to ensure that people work their assigned shifts. The process used last season for reminding people to cover their assigned times/job seemed to work well. Gameday assignments require about 30 people to cover all jobs. Carrie Stohl offered to help whomever takes over concessions.

VII. Coach's Report

Coach Junko thanked everyone who helped make the banquet a success. He expressed what a special night it is for seniors as well as all players. He recognized the work the boosters do in terms of planning and preparation.

Coach Junko welcomed the newly elected board members, and thanked them and asked all boosters for their continued help and support.

Updates- Winter lifting schedule is Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. There are 150 cartons of chocolate milk to be delivered next Monday, January 20th. All players are welcome to chocolate milk before and after their lift. Coach Junko asked that any players working with another trainer to please make Mr. Cremonese (Coach Crem) aware, so that the kids are not working the same muscle groups, etc. Coach

discussed the importance of nutrition and sleep, and asked that parents help the players with this in order for the kids to achieve their goals of being bigger, stronger, and faster.

Workouts for specific positions will begin in February/March.

Recruitment meetings- Meetings for current juniors are taking place on lifting days at 4:15. Meetings will last about an hour. This meeting covers questions about recruiting specifics, etc. Email or call Coach Junko to schedule. January and February is the best time to have a meeting, as schools come back to visit in April and May.

Coach expressed that the true focus of the program is to provide kids with a unique and awesome experience. Surplus of fundraising from last season will be put towards something new and exciting for the kids.

Coach said he will be putting together a budget for the season per the board's request.
